

Academic Scholarship Information

The school is looking for candidates of exceptional academic and leadership ability who will be expected to make an outstanding contribution to the academic life of the school. Performance and progress will be reviewed regularly. This award is made without regard to parental income and is worth up to 20% of the fees. Alternatively, parents who do not require financial assistance may accept their child's scholarship on an honorary basis.

This scholarship is awarded to candidates who are academically gifted in one or more of these subjects: Maths, Science or English. All Academic Scholars are expected to be fully committed to their academic studies.

All Academic Scholars are expected to:

- Play a leading role in the academic and general life of the school
- Be fully committed to their academic studies, showing high levels of motivation
- Maintain an excellent homework record
- Take part in Able, Gifted and Talented extension clubs run by the school
- Be leaders, excellent role models and ambassadors within the school

Retention of the award will be dependent on consistently excellent performance levels, exemplary conduct and continual application to their studies.

Standard required:

Scholarship assessment is based on academic ability as well as whether the candidate demonstrates appropriate character, intelligence and community-mindedness.

The Application Process:

Candidates should provide references from teachers giving an accurate assessment of academic performance and potential in support of their application. The application form and testimonial should be received by the school by **Friday 21 November 2025**. Applicants for the Academic Scholarship who score sufficiently highly across the board (level 7 or above) in their assessment test in November will be invited to a further assessment during the week beginning **Monday 12 January 2026**. This will test their thinking skills, English and Maths, and will include an interview.
